

Video 1. Neutrophil migration to the wound in a severe damage model. Lateral view of the tail of a 48hpf Tg(mpx:GFP)ⁱ¹¹⁴ with caudal fin transection. The first neutrophils that reached the wound traveled through the extracellular matrix. Later, migration primarily occurred through the circulatory system. This can be evidenced with the sudden emergence of neutrophils at the circulatory loop near the injured area.
